- Contribute positively to a safe Club environment

Additional Expectations of SKOBFC Players:

- Demonstrate a commitment to the team rules and player guidelines as determined by the Match Committee
- Refrain from on-field and off-field behaviour which may bring discredit to the Club
- Support the social and community activities of the Club
